

## How to obtain an Absentee Ballot:

\* You must first be registered to vote. If not, you will need to complete that step. That can be done online until March 12th on the [MyVote](#) website. After that date, the clerk can register people until March 28th in person at the town hall (by appointment only). (Proof of residency and a photo ID is required in order to register.)

\* Requesting an absentee ballot - Please go to the [MyVote](#) website. This will walk you through how to request an absentee ballot and upload your ID to complete the request. By using this site, it automatically gets them entered at the county level and expedites the process.

IF they do not want to use the website to request a ballot, they can complete the form (Absentee Ballot Request Form), upload a copy of their ID (REQUIRED), and email it to [townofdewhurst@wisconsin.gov](mailto:townofdewhurst@wisconsin.gov). I legally cannot take verbal requests or requests without the proper form and ID. They may also "snail mail" the request to N103 Riviera Ave., Merrilan, WI 54754. They should be aware of the deadlines to request ballots and plan accordingly for slow mail processing. **(ALL requests will require an ID (unless a previous absentee ballot has been requested).**

**\* *Deadline to request an absentee ballot is March 27th.***

\* Absentee ballots must be returned no later than 8pm on April 1st (voting day). They need to be aware of the due date and plan accordingly to return their ballot on time. Late ballots do NOT get counted.

The first mailing of ballots will be March 11<sup>th</sup>/12<sup>th</sup> to the address requested to receive the ballot.

In person absentee voting will be done by appointment only and is allowed only from March 18<sup>th</sup> -30<sup>th</sup>.
